Undergraduate Research Grants

Undergraduate students are encouraged to apply for an Undergraduate Research Grant administered by the Undergraduate Studies Office in collaboration with Associated Students, Inc. Students are currently able to apply during each spring semester for funding for the following academic year. These grants provide up to \$1,000 in financial support to undergraduate students who work closely with a faculty member to conduct research, engage in field studies, create projects in their discipline, or participate in similar scholarly/creative activities. Students are encouraged to design their own projects but may also work on a professor's project. Either way, students must work closely with a faculty mentor and are encouraged to contact faculty in preparation for making an Undergraduate Research Grant proposal.

Undergraduate Research Grant Eligibility

-Students must be enrolled as full-time undergraduate students with at least two semesters remaining before they will graduate,

-be in good academic standing (minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher),

-show substantial initiative in the project, and

-have a faculty mentor who is willing to work with the student.

-Projects from all majors are eligible for the Undergraduate Research Grant.

-Students may only apply for one grant per academic year.

Faculty Mentor Eligibility

-Faculty member must be tenured or tenure-track faculty,

-willing to work closely with the undergraduate student on the project,

-have knowledge/expertise in the area of project to be completed, and

-demonstrate the ability to effectively mentor an undergraduate student.

Selection of Undergraduate Research Grant Recipients

Research proposals are reviewed by a specifically designated committee from the Undergraduate Studies Office and Associated Students, Inc. Each proposal is carefully rated on:

-overall quality of the research proposal,

-if students are applying for grants to work on the same research project (students **must** indicate their individual roles, unique research question and/or separate assignments for the given project),

-significance of the project and merit of the work involved toward the student's area of study,

-appropriateness of the methodology/creative focus,

-potential for completion of the proposed project, and

-strength of proposed mentoring relationship.

Undergraduate Research Grant Recipient Requirements

-Students must work closely with their faculty mentor.

-complete their project by the specified deadline,

-submit a final report to the Undergraduate Studies Office by March 31, 2018, and -spend funds by March 31, 2018.

Completed online applications are due Sunday, April 23, 2017. *Students and faculty will be notified of award by June 14, 2017.*


