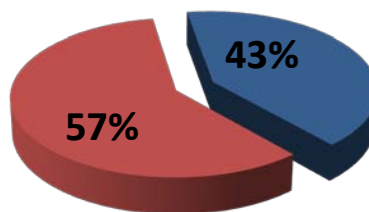

- Asian American students are more likely than other groups to enter as first-time freshman instead of transfer students.
- They have the highest rate of needing English remediation.
- They have the second highest first-year retention rate (less than one percentage point lower than Whites).
