

# Abbreviated PROGRAM REVIEW

## For Nationally Accredited Programs

Programs that participate in a national accreditation process, which includes a site-visit, may conduct an abbreviated campus program review. The abbreviated review still requires that expectations of APM 220 be met, but in an alternate fashion.

### Program Review Tasks

#### University Review

1. Program is notified of University Program Review
2. Identify Self-Study Coordinator & Attend Orientation
3. Prepare Self-Study
4. Final Self-Study to Program Review Officer
5. Review Team Site-Visit
6. Review Team Report is Submitted
7. Dept.'s Response to Review Team Report is Submitted
8. Dean's Response to Review Team Report is Submitted

#### Nationally Accredited Program

1. Accrediting Body conducts Review (including Site-Visit)
2. Dept. submits the following to Program Review Officer(s):

- Self-Study \*See Below
- Review Team Report
- Dept.'s Response
- Dean's Response



- Student Outcomes Assessment Plan (SOAP)
- Findings of the Site-Visit
- Final Accreditation Decision

#### Shared Tasks:

University Committee Review (UGC and/or UAPRS)  
Department submits Action Plan to Program Review Officer(s)  
Planning/Implementation Meeting  
Final Action Plan Submitted and signed



#### Memo:

##### APM 220 Expectations

- 1 The Mission and goals of the program and their relation to the mission and strategic priorities of the institution
- 2 The curriculum through which program mission and goals are pursued
- 3 The assessment of student learning outcomes, program revisions based upon those outcomes, and plans for future assessment activities
- 4 The range and quality of research activities, emphasizing those involving students
- 5 The quality and diversity of faculty and staff and their contributions to program mission and goals
- 6 The quality of entering students (for graduate programs and others with restricted enrollment)
- 7 Libraries and other educational resources
- 8 Physical facilities
- 9 Service and Contributions to the community

#### \*The Self-Study

Instead of writing a traditional self-study, a program simply provides a hyperlink or memo (pointing to) where APM 220 expectations are addressed in the national accreditation documents.
